What if Faith Changed Your Life?

Hebrews chapter 11 is often known as the "Hall of Fame" of Faith. The chapter starts with the Bible's definition of faith. The writer penned, "Now faith is the substance (realization) of things hoped for, the evidence (confidence) of things not seen (Heb. 11:1)."

Things not seen is one of the themes that runs through this chapter. God made the universe from things that were not visible (Heb.11:3). Noah was divinely warned of things not yet seen (11:7). Abraham left his home headed for a place that he did not know and had not seen (11:8). He waited for a city that was made by God (11:10). Many died in faith not having received the promises (11:13). They were waiting for a heavenly country (11:16). Moses looked to a reward (11:26). Moses endured seeing Him who is invisible (11:27). All of these things were connected to faith of the great patriarchs of old.

These people's lives were changed by their faith in things they could not see. I am not sure what Noah's life was like before God appeared to him, but whatever it was he gave it up. He took up preaching and probably spent 100 years building a giant ark (Gen. 6:3). Abraham came from a family that seems to have been well off, but at the age of 75 he left that behind to go to a place that he knew nothing about (Gen. 12:1-4). Moses had access to all the riches of Egypt, but he gave that up to suffer affliction with the people of God. He esteemed the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt. He feared God more than the King of Egypt (Heb. 11:24-27).

Can you imagine allowing God's word to change your life the way these people did? Most of us understand that when we become Christians, we are supposed to do our best to give up the life of sin. But what if our belief called for us to completely change our life? What if we had a job that we realized we should not be doing because it violated our Christian beliefs? What is we realized we had the talent to do another job? What if God's word moved us to preach to Gospel? What if it called us to leave our home to take that Gospel to a foreign land?

God's word is a beautiful thing. It is definitely going to step on our toes at times. When that happens, we need to be willing to change. If it is a life of sin, we should be willing to leave it behind. If it is the call of a new work, we should be ready to answer. As Isaiah boldly proclaimed, "Here I am! Send me (Isa. 6:8)"
