

# Sunday is Still the Lord's Day

In early history of the church there were those, commonly called Sabbatarians, who wanted to insist the day of worship for Christians was Saturday, and that the laws concerning the Sabbath should be observed on that day (Exodus 31:13-18). Some scholars say there are actually 613 specific rules regarding the observance of the Sabbath. The Sabbath was given to the Jews as part of their law, but the whole law was taken out of the way and nailed to the cross when Jesus died (Colossians 2:14; Ephesians 2:14-16). Christians are not commanded to observe the Sabbath. As early as A.D. 52-54 (the date of Paul's writing 1 Corinthians), the first day of the



week, Sunday, was being observed as the day Christians came together to worship because it was the day of our Lord rose from the dead (1 Corinthians 16:2; Acts 20:7; Mark 16:2). There is no Christian Sabbath, and Christians are not required to observe the Sabbath laws.

The only time the phrase the Lord's Day is used in scripture in Revelation 1:10 which was written between A.D. 92-96. It seems clear that by this time this term was being commonly used for Sunday. The Didache written about A.D. 70-110 records, "But every Lord's Day gather yourselves together, break bread, and give thanksgiving." Ignatius of Antioch (A.D. 110) wrote, "No longer observing the Sabbath, but living in true observance of the Lord's Day."

While there are no specific rules regarding how Christians should observe the Lord's Day, I remember the old blue laws when almost every business was closed. The Lord's Day was recognized as a day of worship, and the Lord's resurrection was honored. DO we still honor the Lord's Day? DO we understand the importance of being together on this day and worshipping God and honoring the sacrifice of our Lord by observing the memorial supper He Himself instituted? Do we make a special effort to be present unless providentially hindered? May we be among those who still recognize Sunday as the Lord's Day.


