No One Ever Cared for Me Like Jesus

In Matt. 8:1-3, Mark 1:40-42, and Luke 5:12-13, the Gospel writers record a miracle of Jesus healing a man with leprosy. After Jesus came down from the mountain from a certain city, there was a multitude that followed Him, and a man with leprosy approached Him. According to Pousma, "Leprosy was greatly feared by the Israelites, not only because of the physical damage done by the disease, but also because of the strict isolation laws applying to leprosy, making the patients feel like feared outcasts of society."

When Jesus saw the man's appearance and noticed that the man was completely covered with leprosy, that is, he was probably in the last stages of leprosy, He was not afraid of the leper and did not treat him as an outcast. Since the man was at the last stage of his leprosy, he was possibly past all hope and felt helpless. When he sees Jesus, he would be desperate and feel compelled to approach the Lord for healing since the Jewish people had no cure for leprosy other than God. Jesus Christ was his only hope.

The leper bowed before the Lord and made a request, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, will You make me clean?" Jesus felt compassion for this man and stretched His hand out towards him. You can imagine as Jesus' hand was drawing closer to the man with leprosy as he says, "I am willing to be cleansed." And as Jesus' hand came into contact with the



leper, the leper was immediately healed; he was completely cleansed of his leprosy. This is amazing! He no longer suffered the symptoms of his previous condition and is finally clean. We can imagine him rejoicing at this time with excitement since he no longer had to be isolated from society. He was free from his disease. After spending some time with Jesus, he could surely say, "No one ever cared for me like Jesus." The same thing is true for those of us who have been healed by the Lord of Life, who has redeemed us from our spiritual disease of sin.






