

When Francisco Franco was leading the revolution in Spain, he originated the phrase "the fifth column." Franco was trying to capture Madrid. He said that he had four columns marching on the city, one from the north, one from the south, one from the east, and one from the west. And most important he had a "fifth column" within the city (Encyclopedia of Sermon Illus., pg. 134-135). Franco considered his best weapon to be the one that was attacking his enemy from within.



Jesus knew something about these methods as does the devil. At one point during the ministry of Jesus, the Pharisees claimed that He was casting out demons by the power of Beelzebub. Jesus said that it was not logical for Satan to do battle against himself, because if he battled against himself how would his kingdom stand (Matt. 12:22-26)? The saying "divide and conquer" has often been attributed to Julius Caesar. It is certainly a viable method, but it is likely that it far predates Caesar. We usually think of this method in terms of overcoming an opposing force, but what if we take this down to a personal level? Think about how cancer works. It spreads within a person. The longer it is left to its work the more damage it does. It eats a person up from within. What about sin?

Consider the words of Paul in Romans seven. "For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is persist with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find." Did even Paul struggle with this? He further said that he saw another law in his members, warring against the law of his mind, and bringing him into captivity to the law of sin which was in his members (Rom. 7:15-23).

Sin is like a cancer. It works from within the heart and mind. If you open the door, it will eat you up from inside. James wrote, "But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death (James 1:14-15)."

We all struggle with sin. One of the first steps in getting right with God is admitting this fact. Once we admit it then we need to be able to identify the species of our struggles. Those are the things from which we need to remove ourselves. No matter how small those desires are, if we allow them to hang around, they will grow. Eventually, we will give in, and if we are not careful, we will be overcome by them. In the words of Barney Fife, the best thing to do is "nip it in the bud." Do not give it a chance to grow. Do not let yourself be taken over by the enemy from within.




