### **Condemned by Scripture**

In John chapter five there is a section of Scripture that is often titled "The Fourfold Witness" (John 5:31ff.) Towards the end of this chapter Jesus told His Jewish listeners that He would not accuse them before the Father, but that it would be Moses that accused them (John 5:45). This might seem strange considering that Moses had been gone for somewhere around fifteen hundred years. How would Moses be the one to accuse them?

This brings to mind a similar section of Scripture in Hebrews chapter eleven. In the section that talks about Noah, the writer said that by his faith Noah condemned the world (Heb. 11:7). Noah's faith had moved him to build the ark. He had not seen a flood, but he had been warned that one was on the way. It was not Noah's fault the rest of the world drowned. However, he did show that a person could move with godly fear and do as they have been instructed (Gen. 6:22). Peter told us that Noah was a preacher of righteousness (2 Peter 2:5). Noah's actions and preaching presented a message that condemned the world.

If we go back to our passage in John five and read further, we read that Jesus says that Moses wrote about him (John 5:46). Jesus also said that if they did not believe the writings of Moses, they also would not believe His words (John 5:47). Why? It is because those words came from the same place. The writings of Moses came from God. In this same section of Scripture Jesus has already given the implication that the words He speaks are from the Father (John 5:36-39). Later John explicitly records that Jesus was speaking on behalf of the Father (John 14:24).



The point Jesus was making was that the Scriptures described what He was going to be like (John 5:39). Jesus also said that Moses wrote about Him (John 5:46). If the people did not recognize and believe that Jesus was the one written of in the Scriptures, they certainly were not going to believe anything He had to say. Therefore, in a way they were being condemned by the writings of Moses. This was a bit of a slap in the face, since Moses was loved by the Jews and his

writings would have been at the center of their theological studies.

If the Jews were condemned by Moses through his writings, who will condemn us today? The answer was just as ironic for the Jews as it is for us today. Jesus has been given authority by the Father to execute judgment (John 5:26-27). Jesus is the one that will condemn, but much in the same way it is through His word which comes from the Father (John 12:48-50).

It seems strange that the Jews of Jesus' day would be condemned by the words of Moses, since those were the words they claimed to love. Will it seem strange to those who look back on our generation to see that so many claimed to love Jesus, but so few actually followed His teachings? Hopefully, those reading these words will be ones that not only claim to follow Jesus, but show that they do by their actions (John 14:15, 23)




