

I struck up a conversation with him, inquired how his day was going, then finally got around to asking what I needed to do to pay my fine.

Just then a young student burst through the station door, interrupting our conversation. He had long, limp blonde hair, and a straggly beard, and was loudly complaining in a whiney annoyed voice: "I can't believe you gave me another ticket, just because I parked at Strauss Hall. Who issues these tickets anyway, Barney Fife? This is ridiculous. I pay thousands of dollars for an education, and you expect me to walk three blocks to my class! I'm a student. 


